

# Founding National Organizations for the Constitutional National Committee

The Constitutional National Committee (CNC) will be a combination of national organizations that support the Constitution and stand for limited government. A representative from each of the founding organizations will have a seat at the table. For example, an Association promoting the right to bear arms will have one representative to fill the 2nd amendment seat. There are fifty seats in the founding committee, broken down into eight areas of importance. See the chart below.

The committee will set an agenda, determine strategy and put forth their platform. The platform will then be set before the entire membership of the CNC. As members of the CNC, individual Americans will have the opportunity to have their vote counted and their voice heard. Once approved, the CNC's platform will be supported by every contributing national organization and the millions of like-minded individuals that support them. Limited government politicians, regardless of political party, can be confident that the platform of the CNC will already have met the approval of the millions of Americans supporting the CNC and its member organizations.
